Earthlight, by Shamardal, was unbeaten in five starts as a two-year-old, with his wins including the six-furlong G1 double, the Prix Morny and the Middle Park.

This colt is from Earthlight's second crop. His first European crop has borne 19 winners including the G3 winner and G1-placed Daylight.

His dam was a dual-Sydney metro winner by Lonhro, who is emerging as an important broodmare sire.
